

BERMUDA GRASS VARIETY



Bermuda grass is a plant that is grown as a turf grass or as a forage for livestock, but it can also be an invasive weed. Bermuda is low growing and goes dormant in the wintertime. It is a turf species often seen on sports fields and survives well at high temperatures.

KIKUYU GRASS VARIETY



Kikuyu is an extremely aggressive perennial weed or turf grass. It is often mistaken as St Augustine grass. Kikuyu is a warm season grass that can maintain its growth rate at lower temperatures. It often turns brown in the wintertime. It can easily be moved from one area to another on mowing and renovation equipment.

ST AUGUSTINE GRASS VARIETY



St. Augustine grass is a warm-season turf grass (dormant in winter). It is water efficient and has few pest problems. It prefers sun, but has a high tolerance for shade. It grows quickly in the summertime, but slows down during the spring and fall as it reaches its dormancy period. Augustine grass has a creeping growth habit.

CRAB GRASS WEED



Crab grass is a summer/spring weed that has varieties of both smooth and hairy blades. It is a low-growing, summer annual that spreads by seed. It dies with the first frost in fall. Unmowed it will grow up to 6 inches.

TALL FESCUE GRASS VARIETY



Tall fescue is a cool season grass that stays green all year long. It tolerates warm summer temperatures and stays green during the wintertime. Tall fescue is a good species to plant for general lawn use. It will tolerate moderate traffic and frequent mowing.
