AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

All Mutual Presidents are responsible for many unique tasks. Signing contracts and checks and stock certificates. Planning and attending lots of meetings. New buyer orientations. Assisting the families of shareholders as they navigate the details of moving a family member into care, or selling a unit. And regretably, overseeing the passing or incapacitation of a shareholder. Unfortunately, I have been thrust into quite a number of difficult situations due to the lack of communication between shareholders and family members. It is imperative that shareholders take care of the following things:

- Keep your stock certificate, will or trust, financial records, ID card and other important papers in one secure place, and MAKE SURE YOUR FAMILY KNOWS WHERE THESE ITEMS ARE LOCATED.
- Make sure your emergency contacts are up to date. Correct phone numbers are essential.
- If you do not have a trust, and/or you have not established power of attorney, do it as soon as possible.

My husband and I set up our trust, our living will, and our power of attorney many years ago. We did not want to burden our loved ones with uncertainty and unnecessary heartache if they were called upon to act on our behalf.
